We would like to thank you for all the support you have shown so far for this new little B/C series. We hope you are enjoying the shows. Please let us know if there is anything we can do to improve this new series. We are trying to make this a little different so here are some of the new ideas we have.

The Series Classic Show will be a special format. Each Jumper section will consist of our standard 3 classes with the last class being a high stakes classic. Each Hunter section will consist of a first & second round standard hunter courses and the third round will be a Handy style course. The second & third round classes will have additional Overall High Point prize money (the two classes will be combined like a Classic for a set of overall results).

The Bluebonnet Medal Classic will be run closer to a collegiate class in the hopes to give riders a little taste of what college class would be like and maybe get coaches to come and watch the class. Please check the website for specifics on how this class will be run.

Please take note of the NEW Performance Classes that have been added by the USEF this year. There is no longer a Regular Working Section, but they have now made it possible for trainers to have a Section to show the 3'9", 3'6" & 3'3" horses that no longer qualify for the Pre-Green and Green sections.

If there is anything we can do to make the shows better please don't hesitate to let us know as we are always looking for ways to improve your show experience.

BLUEBONNET SHOW SERIES

The following shows are operated in accordance with the current rules of the: TEXAS HUNTER & JUMPER ASSOCIATION by which they are recognized and rated "B" in Perf., A/O, Pony, Green Pony, Children's Hunter Pony, Children's and Adult Hunter, and Children's, Adult and Pony Jumper. Points for placing in Children's, Pony and Adult Equitation will be credited in accordance with the rules of THJA.

Class 500 Jumper Classic Entry Fee: \$100

FENCE HEIGHTS: 1.05 m

ENTRIES CLOSE AT 12 Saturday. Order of go will be drawn at 2pm on Saturday. Post entries will be placed at the top of the order. In the jump off, horses will go in original drawn order. This class will be run under USEF Table II, Section 2(A/B). Each competitor will jump one round over a course of at least 14 fences at DESIGNATED FENCE HEIGHTS PER WEEK. Water obstacles may be included in the course. After the first round, in the event of equality of faults for first place only, there will be a jump off in which time will decide the winner. The remaining competitors will be placed according to their faults in the first round with time being used to break any ties. Riders will be asked to wear black, gray, navy, dark green or scarlet coats. **Minimum of 8 entries** or the prize money will be redistributed per Management. Fences Heights are also up to Management discretion.

Class 502 3' Hunter Derby Classic Entry Fee: \$100

504 Hunter Specifications: To be judged on performance and soundness, suitability, and manners. To be scored under the open numerical judging system using two (2) judges (when available). Each round will consist of approximately 12 fences of typical Hunter style jumps including walls & natural brush. The first round will be over a Classic Hunter style course. The second round will be narrowed to the top 12 from the first round and will ride over a Handy Hunter style course. During the Handy Round, horses will have the opportunity to gain handiness points, 1-10. Scores from the two rounds will add together for the total overall score. **Minimum of 8 entries** or the prize money will be redistributed per Management.

Zone HOTY Bonus points to horses shown by professionals in the Performance 3'3" and Pre-green divisions. Bonus points for horses ridden by Jr/Amateurs will be awarded in the Pre-green, Performance 3'3" or in the Children's, Adults, Pony or Amateur Owner 3'3" Sections.

Class 504 Pony Hunter Classic Entry Fee: \$100

Restrictions: Small ponies will jump 2'3", Medium ponies will jump 2'6" and Large ponies will jump 2'9(greens)/3'. SECOND ROUND OF EACH SECTION, ON THE DAY OF THE CLASSIC, WILL BE SCORED AS THE FIRST ROUND OF THE CLASSIC. To be eligible to compete in the Pony Hunter Classic, the same pony and rider combination must have shown in the Pony Hunter Division at the same show. To be scored under the Open Numerical Judging System. The top twelve (12) ponies will return for a second round over a different course. Scores from both rounds will be totaled to determine the placing. **Minimum of 8 entries**. Prize money will be distributed as stated in the Rules & Regulations. Open to working hunter ponies and green hunter ponies.

A jump order will be drawn & posted prior to the first jumper class. The order will be systematically rotated each day. All ties in Jumper classes, for other than first place, will be broken based on time in first round. Children & Adult Jumpers will be combined if there are less than eight in either section. Time allowed will be based on 382 yards per minute.

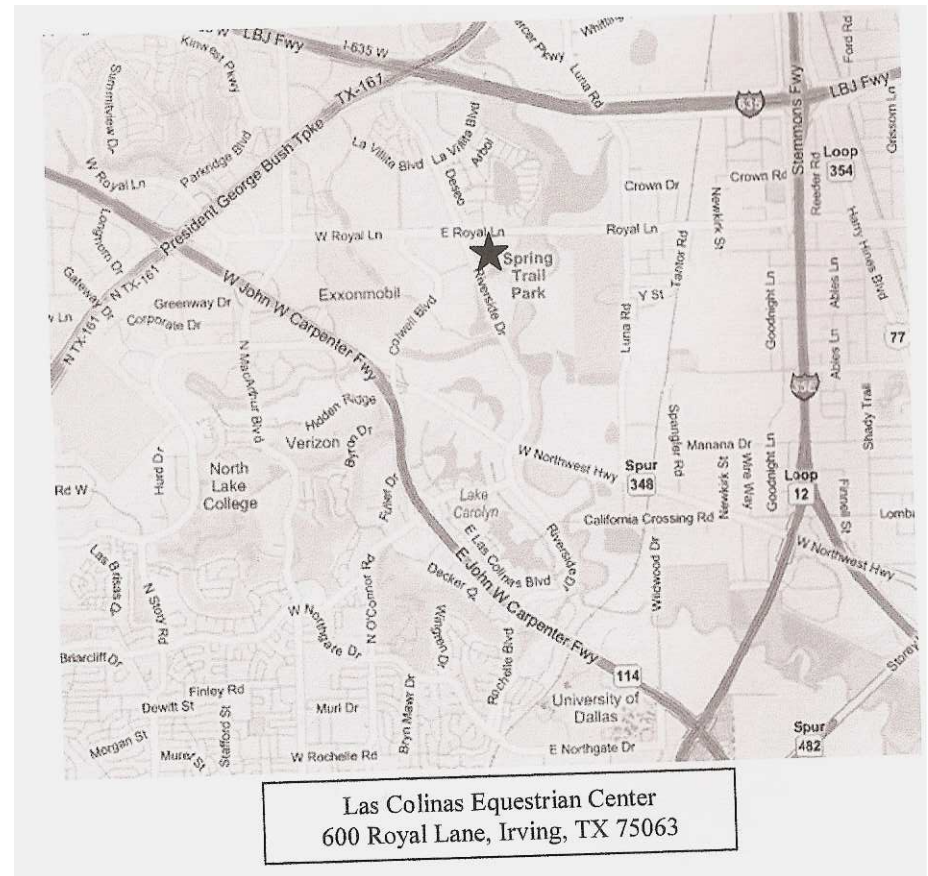

Courses will simulate fences found in the hunting field such as: brush, wall, in & out, oxe, post/rails, gates, aiken, and panels. In some classes the area of the Courtesy Circle may be restricted by mandatory line. This line will be indicated on the course diagram and physically in the ring. Classes will be judged on performance and soundness unless otherwise noted in the prize list. *Sections WITH LESS THAN SIX ENTRIES will be combined & any combined section with less than six entries may be canceled. 7. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. ***The parent(s), legal guardian(s), or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation.*** Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.

USHJA Stirrup Cup Awards

The goal of the awards program is to recognize the accomplishments of USHJA members and to promote the B and C level competitions. This awards program is a separate program from the USEF Horse of the Year Program. The USHJA Stirrup Cup Awards are an additional and unique awards program that you are automatically enrolled in by being a member of USHJA and competing in B and C rated competitions.

2. Points will be earned from September 16—Sept 15 of the competition year.
3. Must be a registered member of USHJA

Rules and Regulations

This show is a regular member of the United States Equestrian Federation (USEF). Every class offered herein which is covered by the rules and specifications of the current USEF rule book will be conducted and judged in accordance therewith.

ENTRIES: Post entries into a class will be accepted the day before at NO Charge but there will be a \$15 fee for any post entry done the same day. **ENTRY BLANKS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED UNLESS SIGNED BY THE OWNER/ AUTHORIZED AGENT, TRAINER & ACCOMPANIED BY A CHECK FOR STABLING OR AN OPEN CHECK. NO NUMBERS WILL BE ISSUED WITHOUT AN OPEN CHECK. THERE WILL BE A \$35.00 LATE FEE FOR ENTRIES POSTMARKED AFTER THE DEADLINES. CURRENT COGGINS MUST BE PRESENTED TO THE HORSE SHOW OFFICE FOR ALL HORSES.** THE PERSON EXECUTING THE ENTRY IS RESPONSIBLE FOR COMPLETING ALL NECESSARY INFORMATION PERTAINING TO EACH ENTRY IN ACCORDANCE WITH RULES OF USEF. \$35.00 office fee will be charged for every horse on the show grounds.

STALLS: ENTRIES MUST BE POSTMARKED BY FEB.10, 2012, FOR THE WINTER BLAST STALL FEES ARE \$55/ DAY (no overnight stay) OR \$95/WEEKEND IF RESERVED BY DEADLINE. Manure to be disposed of in designated areas. NO MANURE IN TRASH CONTAINERS. No stall doors or panels may be removed. NOTE: A \$30.00 grounds fee per day will be charged for all horses not purchasing a stall. NO OUTSIDE SHAVINGS ALLOWED.

LATE FEES: ALL late entries will be billed \$35 late charge.

REFUNDS: Entry fees will not be refunded unless a certificate of illness or injury prepared by an accredited veterinarian is presented to the secretary before the start of the show. Once the show has started, proper notification of the scratch must be made in the show office BEFORE the start of the class or classes being scratched. In either case, there will be an office processing charge of \$50.00.

RETURNED CHECKS: \$35.00 will be charged for all returned checks. Accounts will be given 5 days to pay with certified funds or be reported to the USEF according to GR1508.1.

CREDENTIALS: ALL EXHIBITORS IN THE PONY, JUNIOR HUNTER AND ANY AMATEUR SECTION MUST PRESENT THEIR MEASUREMENT CARD AND/OR AMATEUR CERTIFICATIONS at the show office before their numbers can be released. To speed processing send a Photostat of your card with your entry blank. All ponies or horses that do not have a current measurement card will be measured at a time and place to be announced. Anyone not presenting a current USEF / THJA membership card (or copy thereof) will be charged a Non-Member fee or if a current member, and unable to present your membership card, you may submit the appropriate affidavit & fee to these associations.

CHANGES: Management reserves the right to change, cancel or combine classes, alter courses and do all things necessary to compensate for excessive or inadequate entries.

DRUGS and MEDICATIONS: Current USEF rules relating to drugs and medications will be enforced. Each horse entered must pay \$8.00 Drug / Medication Fee plus a \$7.00 USEF fee.

SCHOOLING: Will be allowed from noon Friday until 6 pm Schooling will allowed from daylight until 15 minutes to start time in each ring. **HARD HATS MUST BE WORN WHILE MOUNTED.**

CAMPERS: We have limited camper spaces at \$40/DAILY. Please reserve your space with your entry form.

DOGS: Dogs are not permitted to be loose on competition grounds and must be on a leash or otherwise contained. Individuals must not lead dogs on a leash while mounted. Dog owners failing to comply with this rule may be subject to penalty under Ch. 6 & 7, as well as issuance of warning cards. Loose dogs may be impounded by Animal Control.

ATTIRE: It is compulsory for riders in all Hunter, Jumper and Hunt Seat Equitation classes, both open and restricted including Hunter Hack, where jumping is required and when mounted anywhere on the show grounds to wear properly fastened protective headgear which meets or exceeds ASTM (American Society for Testing Materials) /SEI (Safety Equipment Institute) standards for equestrian use and carries the SEI tag. It must be properly fitted with harness secured. Any rider violating this rule at any time must immediately be prohibited from further riding until such headgear is proper in place. See GR801.2. Riders must be properly attired. Protective head gear must be worn. Numbers must be worn and clearly visible. See USEF GR801.9.

HORSE REGISTRATION: All horses competing in Federation non-breed restricted licensed competitions with hunter, hunter breeding, jumper and hunter seat equitation classes (except those activities enumerated in GR901.9, items 1-9) must be properly identified and must obtain a Registration Number from USHJA. A registration number for each horse must be entered on all entry forms for licensed competitions. Only one Registration Number will be issued per horse, and must remain with the horse throughout its career. Anyone knowingly applying for a duplicate Registration Number for an individual horse may be subject to disciplinary action. The Federation and/or USHJA as applicable must be notified of any change of ownership and/or competition name of the horse. Owners are requested to notify the Federation and/or USHJA as applicable of corrections to previously submitted information, e.g., names, addresses, breed registration, pedigree, or markings.

In accordance with GR1111.4: All members may compete for Zone Awards or money in any state contiguous to Zone 7: MS, TN, KY, IA, IL, NE, CO & NM

Adult Amateur Hunter:

To be ridden by Amateurs no longer eligible to compete as Junior exhibitors. Open to horses and ponies. State rules may prohibit entry of ponies (see exception paragraph below). Cross Entry: The same rider/horse (pony) combination may not compete at the same show in any class (equitation and USHJA National Hunter Derby excepted) in which fence heights exceed 3'3". The rider may compete on a different horse or pony at the same show in any other division or section for which the rider/mount are eligible. The horse or pony may be shown by a different rider in any other division or section at the same show except Amateur Owner Hunter or a different age group in Adult Amateur Hunter. Exception: A state association may adopt more (but not less) restrictive cross entry rules (see below). Course and Judging Specifications: Fence height: 3', spread not to exceed fence height. Courses will not be adjusted for ponies. To be judged on performance, soundness, manners, way of going, and suitability of mount to rider. Entries are not required to jog for soundness. **The Adult Amateur and Children's Hunter sections may be combined if there are less than four in either section.**

Children's Hunter: To be ridden, and handled in all phases of competition, by Junior exhibitors. Open to horses and ponies. State rules may prohibit entry of ponies (see exception paragraph below). Cross Entry: The same rider/horse (pony) combination may not compete at the same show in any class (equitation and USHJA National Hunter Derby excepted) in which fence heights exceed 3'3". The rider may compete on a different horse or pony at the same show in any other division or section for which the rider/mount are eligible. The horse or pony may be shown by a different rider in any other division or section at the same show except Junior Hunter or a different age group in Children's Hunter. Exception: A state association may adopt more (but not less) restrictive cross entry rules (see below). Course and Judging Specifications: Fence height: 3', spread not to exceed fence height. Courses will not be adjusted for ponies. To be judged on performance, soundness, manners, way of going, and suitability of mount to rider. Entries are not required to jog for soundness. **The Adult Amateur and Children's Hunter sections may be combined if there are less than four in either section.** **Children's Hunter Pony:** Open to ponies ridden by a Junior Exhibitor with no other age restrictions applicable. Rider and/or pony may enter any Equitation classes. The rider may compete on a different horse or pony at the same show in any other division or section where the jumps do not exceed 3'. The pony may be shown by a different rider in any other division or section at the same show except USEF Rated Hunter Pony classes. To be judged on performance, soundness, manners, way of going, suitability of size of rider to mount, and suitability as a Children's Hunter. Ponies not required to be jogged for soundness. Small ponies to be shown at 2', Medium Ponies at 2'3", and Large Ponies at 2'6"; spreads not to exceed height of fence. **Children's Hunter Pony sections cannot be combined with either or both of the Children's Hunter Horse or Adult Amateur divisions.** No minimum prize money is required.

Adult Amateur Jumper: To be ridden by Amateurs who are no longer eligible to compete as Junior Exhibitors. Cash winnings do not influence this classification.

Children's Jumper: To be ridden by Junior Exhibitors. Cash winnings do not influence this classification.

Class Conditions for Adult Amateur and Children's Jumper: Classes in the Low Adult Amateur and/or Children's Jumper section will be conducted at 1.0m to 1.05m. Classes in the High Adult Amateur and/or Children's Jumper section will be conducted at 1.10m to 1.15m. If only one section is offered, the classes will be conducted at 1.10m for all classes offered in the section. Competition Management may restrict cross entries between High and Low sections at the same show if stated in the prize list. Classes to be scored under Table I; Table II, Section I, Sections 2(a), 2(b), 2(c), or 3; or Table IV (Optimum Time). Cross entry into Junior or Amateur Owner Jumper or any class at 1.25m and above is not permitted for the same horse/rider combination at the same show. A combined Adult Amateur/Children's Jumper section may be offered, and if entries warrant, may thereafter be split into separate sections.

Exceptions: An exception is permitted to any or all of the sections described above only under the following conditions: The rule-making organization must be a statewide USEF Affiliated Association. State exceptions can apply only in shows held within that state. State specifications must have been published and sent to each member of the state association, each member of the Zone 7 Committee, USEF and the manager of every show that applies for State Association recognition or sanction. State rules that are valid exceptions to the general Zone 7 specifications can be more restrictive, but cannot reduce or eliminate any of the Zone 7 stated criteria spelled out above and must be printed in their entirety under the applicable section heading in the prize list.

Those likenesses shall not be used to advertise a product and they may not be used in such a way as to jeopardize amateur status. I hereby expressly and irrevocably waive release any rights in connection with such use, including any claim to compensation, invasion of privacy, right of publicity, or to misappropriation. The construction and application of Federation Rules are governed by the laws of the State of New York, and any action instituted against the Federation must be filed in New York State. See GR 908.4
